## Rule Proposals

- Amendment to Membership Rule #6
  - **Proposed rule:** All contestants and contract personnel must be NSRA members prior to August 1st before they can participate at the NSRA finals. Contestant membership dues are \$150 prior to June 1. After June 1, the dues increase to \$160. Dues for student cards (high school and younger) are \$25 and all contract personnel (announcer, judges, stock contractors, pickup men, etc.) are \$60 before June 1 & \$80 after. Any contract personnel who wishes to compete in rodeo events, must purchase a contestant card (or student card, if high school or younger), and also complete the contract personnel portion of the NSRA membership application. No additional dues will be charged for adding the contract personnel to a competing card.

- Amendment to Entry Fees & Prize Money Rule #5
  - **Proposed Rule:** Payoff for all events will be as follows based on the total pot after percent money being taken out:
    - a. \$250 or less, one money
    - b. \$251 to \$400, 2 monies: 60%/40%
    - c. \$401 to \$700, 3 monies: 50%/30%/20%
    - d. \$701 to \$1,800, 4 monies: 40%/30%/20%/10%
    - e. \$1,801 to \$2,300, 5 monies: 30%/25%/20%/15%/10%
    - f. \$2,301 to \$5,000, 6 monies: 29%/24%/19%/14%/9%/5%
    - g. \$5,001 to \$7500, 8 monies: 23%/20%/17%/14%/11%/8%/5%/2%
    - h. \$7,501 and up, 10 monies: 19%/17%/15%/13%/11%/9%/7%/5%/3%/1%

- Amendment to Steer Roping Time Limit
  - **Current Rule:** 30 second time limit (PRCA rulebook)
  - **Proposed Rule:** 45 second time limit

- Amendment to Steer Wrestling Rule #1
  - **Current Rule:** Contestant must furnish own hazer and horses. Steer must be caught from horse. Only one hazer allowed.
  - **Proposed Rule:** Contestant must furnish own hazer and horses. Only one hazer allowed. All cattle must be steers. If a heifer is used, a \$50 fine/run will be assessed to the stock contractor. Judges are responsible for checking livestock. Steer must be caught from horse.

- Amendment to Barrel Racing Rule #18
  - **Current Rule:** Barrel racing positions for the finals will be: First performance will run positions 1-15, according to standings going into the finals. Second performance will be run positions 9-15,1-8. Last performance will run 15-1. Rake after 8 in each round.
  - **Proposed Rule:** Barrel racing positions for the finals will be:
    - First performance will run positions 1-15 rake at 5
    - Second performance will run 9,10,11,12,13 rake, 14,15,1,2,3 rake 4,5,6,7,8
    - Short Go goes by Average going into Short Go 1<sup>st</sup>-15<sup>th</sup>.

- Amendment to Barrel Racing Rule #7
  - **Current Rule:** Contestant will be disqualified for not being ready to contest when her name is called, for missing the pattern, turning a barrel twice, or crossing the finish line prior to completion of run.
  - **Proposed Rule:** Contestant will be disqualified for not being ready or taking longer than 30 seconds when her name is called to get into the arena or starting run, for missing the pattern, turning a barrel twice, or crossing the finish line prior to completion of run.

**Passed 37-5**
- Additional Barrel Racing Rule
  - **Proposed Rule:** If the pattern is centered to the gate, contestant must keep forward motion toward the first barrel and forward motion when leaving the arena, member must be allowed to set up her run as necessary, without CIRCLING, SPINNING OR PIVOTING otherwise be Disqualified. If the pattern is not Centered to the gate, member shall be allowed to set up her run as necessary, without circling, a spin or pivot is acceptable. No intentional dismounting in the arena. If contestant takes excessive amount of time or more than 1 pivot or spin it will result in Disqualification. If you have a question, ask the judge before you run.  
A member will not be considered to have made a circle if when setting up their run they are working within a 12 foot by 12 foot by 12 foot area. You can go in side gate make one 12x12x12

turn towards chutes if you go to opposite barrel (right side gate and you go to left barrel first) without being considered circling.

- Additional Barrel Racing Rule

- **Proposed Rule:** Should for any reason the barrels are not placed on the markers or the flagman not in the correct place, things must be put in correct order and all contestants who ran on the incorrect course must be rerun without penalty.

**Passed 28-11**

- Amendment to Rodeo Committee & NSRA Approved Rodeo Rule #12

- **Current Rule:** All NSRA rodeos that limit the entries in the performances must offer slack for the overflow of contestants if performances are filled.

- **Proposed Rule:** The maximum number of timed event contestants in a 2 performance rodeo will be set at 15. Any additional entries will go in slack. A 1 day rodeo will be exempt from this rule, because a committee might not want to have slack for 1-3 people. In that case, the stock contractor will be required to bring enough livestock so cattle won't be run twice.
